## EMS LEG TRACTION SPLINT

What is It? QD Leg Traction Splint

**Use:** The femur (thighbone) is the strongest bone in the body.

In a fracture, the pieces may become displaced and overlap. A traction splint realigns the bone segments, reducing the patient's pain and discomfort on the way to the hospital.

**How It Works:** The medic inserts the splint's frame under the leg, stabilizing

the leg on the frame with four straps. An ankle hitch around the patient's ankle is attached to an aluminum ratchet. The medic applies traction by turning the ratchet. This action realigns the

fracture and straightens the leg to normal length.
