LUNG TESTING AND TREATMENT

Spirometry Test

Breathing Treatment

Easy One Diagnostic Spirometer:

Pulmo Mate Compression Nebulizer: You place a nose clip, take a deep breath, and blow into the mouthpiece as fast and long as you can. The spirometer records the results. Your spirometry score indicates whether and how much a lung disease, such as asthma or COPD, is reducing lung function.

Patients with a lung disease use a "nebulizer" or air compressor to take prescribed medicine. The nebulizer machine turns liquid medicine into a mist. You fill the medicine cup with your prescription then breathe in through a connected mouthpiece. The medicine goes into your lungs as you take slow, deep breaths for 7-10 minutes.
