Fire Equipment and Technology Alleviates Risks



Air quality device detects gases that explode or are deadly to breathe.

What is It?

MSA Altair 5 - Multigas Detector; Firefighting hose in 1-3/4" and 2-1/2" widths, all used by Love County EMS-Fire Brigade at Station 2, WinStar Casino

Gas Detector:

The handheld device reads the air quality of a home, workplace, or confined area. An alarm sounds if there is a dangerous level of gases that explode and burn or are deadly to breathe.

Fire Hose:

The Ladder Truck goes out with three hoses -- yellow, red, and blue -- neatly folded in 50' sections and already connected to the truck's water supply. With a yank on a handle at the top of its stack, a hose unfurls and fills with water. The yellow hose is 2-1/2" wide and is handled by two firefighters. The red and blue hoses are 1-3/4" wide for single firefighter operation.
